Children's activities

Another month of In the Moment fun has led to lots of learning and lots of fun! Here are some of the lovely interactions we have had with your children;

We read Owl Babies and talked about how swiftly owls can fly. We spoke about their feathers and how they use their wings to fly ; using props we brought the story to' life '

We explored how changing the angle of a ramp can make a vehicle go faster and raced our cars down the ramps. We discussed about different emotions and how we can express them in various ways. We have made some fantastic obstacle courses, allowing us to develop our climbing and balancing skills. We've talked about the importance of using sun cream to protect our skin in the warmer weather.

In the garden we have made mud pies, had fun on the bikes and scooters alongside lots of imaginary role play games that have involved 'super heroes'. These kinds of opportunities are great for boosting confidence in our 'safe' and friendly environment. We have planted tomato plants and sunflower seeds, talking about what plants need to grow. A parent has kindly let us have some Guinea Fowl eggs which are currently in an incubator in preschool and we are excited to watch them hatch in a about a weeks time. We have also had some good conversations about what our brains are, where they are and what they do, not to mention how eating healthy will keep our brains healthy! We've done masses of counting and load of turn taking games too.

We have drawn portraits of Prince William, made a card and sent it to him for his birthday.We are hoping he will write back to say thankyou !



A Few Reminders

Wearing of appropriate clothing, footwear and suncream

Please can we remind you that your children should come to nursery dressed appropriately for the days weather conditions and forecast including footwear.

Clothing - in warmer weather it is lovely for the children to wear their summer clothes(as we have waited long enough for some decent weather!) however we ask that children do not come in strappy tops or dresses as they are at risk from the sun even when sun cream is regularly applied, a short sleeved T-shirt is advised to be worn underneath for extra UV protection.Please make sure your child has enough named spare clothes as mealtimes and playtimes are a sensory experience.

Footwear – Please ensure that your children donot arrive at nursery in such footwear as flip lops etc without alternative, sensible footwear available for them to change into which is appropriate for running and climbingetc. Your children will also have access to waterplay/mud kitchen during the driest of days so you may wish to bring wellies in for them to change into for these activities, and for a change of clothes to be available in their bags.

Hats- Please ensure your child brings a named sun hat for use whilst at nursery.

Suncream- We are continuing to apply Nivea Sun Kids sensitive ,moisturising,water resistant sun cream- factor 50+ to the children throughout the nursery.Should your child be sensitive to this make/brand of suncream we ask that you supply your own preferred cream which is clearly labelled with your childs name.Please apply sun cream to your child in the morning when they are attending nursery.

Arrival/Collection Times

Please ensure you leave and collect your child at the times booked, as several children have been arriving before their session begins and/or have been collected after their session ends. This is particularly prevalent before the 8.45am session and at the end of the 12.45 – 3.15pm session. If you do occasionally arrive early please wait with your child in the lobby until the start of the booked session. If you are also collecting older siblings from school at 3.15pm, please ensure you collect your child from The Ark first. This is very important as we may breach our OFSTED registration conditions if we do not adhere to correct staff/children ratios. End of the Day; as you are all aware as a setting we operate 8am-6pm. This means we close the doors at 6pm, if you require a handover at the end of the day please arrive by 5.50pm so that staff have time to do the handover. If you arrive after this time, handover will be short and limited. Any collections after 6pm will incur a fee.

Just a polite reminder that Tracey our administrator works **Wednesday, Thursday and Friday 0830am-5pm.**We ask that if you would like to discuss ongoing bookings,payments or funding please email or pop in during Traceys working hours.
